In the Matter of the Charitable Trusts Acts, 1853 to 1939.

THE BOARD OF CHARITY COMMISSIONERS FOR ENGLAND AND WALES, upon an application made to them on the 5th December 1946, in writing, signed by GUY HOLFORD BENSON, Merchant Banker; and WILLIAM SPURRETT FIELDING JOHNSON, Farmer; both of Compton Bassett, in the County of Wilts;
the Trustees of the above-mentioned Charity:

DO HEREBY ORDER that the land specified in the Schedule hereto shall forthwith vest in The Official Trustee of Charity Lands for all the estate and interest therein belonging to or held in trust for the Charity.

Land situate at Compton Bassett, in the County of Wilts, and containing one acre or thereabouts which land is part of that numbered 103 on the Ordnance Survey map of the district and is comprised in the above-mentioned Deed of Gift dated 23rd July 1946 made between The Bristol Brewery Georges and Company Limited of the one part and the Trustees of the other part, and recorded in the books of the Charity Commissioners for England and Wales on the 2nd April 1947 pursuant to section 29(4) of the Settled Land Act, 1925.
